Materials needed:

Painting knife (metal, medium size, with elbow) Flat palette (big, wood) if possible with a Dipper. Rags, linseed oil,

Brushes: preferably synthetic, flat and filbert, various sizes including one at least 2cm wide

4-5 boards, canvases, canvas boards, MDF, hardboard or heavy card: primed/sized – ready to go. Various sizes 20 – 40cms, any aspect. And a larger one about A2 size

White Gesso

GAC 100 if using bare MDF boards or other absorbent supports.

Paints:

Acrylic colours for underpainting, earth colours or primaries.

Oil paints:

Ivory Black

Titanium White

Cadmium Red (can be Hue)

Alizarin Crimson (Winton make a useful one)

Burnt Sienna

Cadmium Yellow (or Hue)

Yellow Ochre

Burnt Umber

Raw Umber

Ultramarine Blue

Prussian Blue

Cobalt Blue (can be Hue)
