Please bring:

Acrylic paints: Red, Yellow, Blue, Yellow ochre, Raw umber, Black and white.

Acrylic medium – Gel, Matte or Gloss

A variety of brushes: round and flat, size 2, 6, 8 synthetic fibre.

Pen, paper or notebook for notes.

An apron or old/art shirt.

At **Browne School of Art** we also have a selection of basic materials available for purchase: paper in A1 / A2 sheets: newsprint, cartridge, sugar grey, wet strength, bulldog clips, pencils, charcoal, erasers, white chalk, black ink.

This list is a general guide only. The majority (though not necessarily all) of these materials may be used as students' progress. Canvases, panels and boards can be prepared fairly easily and these need to be to your own preferred formats and sizes. If you are using oil paints please come prepared for this with odourless turpentine and plenty of rags for cleaning up.
